

## **Antique Autos in History Park 2009**

The 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Antique Autos in History Park presented by the Santa Clara Valley Model T Ford Club and History San Jose will take place on Sunday, September 13 from noon to 5:00 PM. This event fills History Park (Kelley Park, 1650 Senter Road, San Jose) with antique autos of all makes from the 1900 to 1945 period, along with antique fire equipment, antique bicycles and motorcycles. Also located on the grounds will be early day gas engines which will power saws, washing machines and other tools needed in the early days.

The JP and the Rhythm Chasers Band will play from 1:00 to 3:00. Down stairs in the Hotel, fun movies which include early day automobiles will be shown, and food can be purchased from Peggy Sue's Restaurant and O'Briens Cafe. Activities will be provided by A Schmahl Science Workshop and San Jose Fire Explorer Post 888 for the children. Many of the participants and visitors (including members of Portraits of the Past) will stroll the grounds in their early 1900s clothing. On the ground floor of the firehouse, there will be displays and demonstrations of early day hand crafts. Antique collectibles will be displayed on the lawn in front of the Hotel.

This year members of the Model T and Horseless Carriage Clubs will again attempt to assemble a Model T in less than 6 minutes.
